Applications for new Local Drug Action Teams (LDATs) are now open!

The LDAT Program is part of the Australian Government's investment of more than \$450 million under the National Ice Action Strategy since 2016-17. The program supports organisations to build or extend local partnerships and develop evidence-based activities to prevent and minimise harms caused by alcohol and other drugs where it matters the most - at the grass-roots, community level.

There are already over 230 active LDATs having an impact around Australia and we're on the lookout for another 40.

Please share the news with your networks, stakeholders and any local groups keen to make a difference to alcohol and other drug use in their communities.
